



Diploma of Entrepreneurship

Calling all aspiring entrepreneurs: The Diploma of Entrepreneurship is a unique program that provides hands-on training and experience in Startups. Learn Ideation, Design Thinking, Customer Research, Storytelling and Business Commercialisation. Develop your entrepreneurship skills and mindset in this practical course that also offers access to venture capital funding.

5 Core Subjects + 3 Specialisation or Elective Subjects



Bachelor of Business

The Bachelor of Business provides foundational business theory and skills with the option of specialising (majoring) in either Accounting or Leadership & Management. Degree subjects cover topics such as marketing, financial reporting, decision-making, and entrepreneurship - preparing you for a range of roles in your future business career. Be equipped with a strong ethical framework to make a positive impact in the world of business.

10 Core Subjects + 8 Specialisation Subjects + 6 Elective Subjects

Diploma of Business

The Diploma of Business is a stand-alone one year course and a potential pathway into the full Bachelor of Business program. The Core subjects introduce key aspects of Business Communication, Marketing, Accounting & Bookkeeping, and Project Management, all within an ethical framework and Christian worldview. If you are taking on extra responsibilities in an existing business or aspiring to start a new business, this course will equip you with practical skills for administrative and decision-making roles.

5 Core Subjects + 3 Specialisation or Elective Subjects

Make it a Double

Combine business or entrepreneurship with other areas of study by adding 6 months for a double diploma or 1 year for a double degree! Combine business or entrepreneurship with leadership, ministry, and theological studies. You can also combine business with entrepreneurship.

DOUBLE DEGREES

Bachelor of Business and Bachelor of Ministry

This course is designed to enable you to provide creative solutions, by integrating your Christian worldview with business acumen, to complex issues such as social and environmental responsibility. Combine a solid core of skills in leadership, management, finance, accounting, and innovative electives, together with ministry training, you become better equipped to serve in Christian ministry.

16 Core Subjects + 1 Specialisation for each Area of Study with 8 Subjects each (16 Subjects)



ENTREPRENEURSHIP DOUBLE DIPLOMAS

Diploma of Entrepreneurship and Diploma of Ministry

This course is designed to produce graduates who embody integrity and can combine Christian leadership principles with entrepreneurial skills to make a positive contribution in business, ministry, or both. Combine handson training in Ideation, Customer Research, Startups with Biblical principles to prepare you for bi-vocational ministry.

9 Core Subjects + 3 Elective Subjects

BUSINESS DOUBLE DIPLOMAS

Diploma of Business and Diploma of Ministry

Combine practical business and management skills with relevant and Biblical training for today's radically evolving ministry landscape. This course is designed to prepare you for a range of ministry contexts that require a combination of business and management expertise, including churches, not-for-profits, and entrepreneurial mission work.

Diploma of Business and Diploma of Entrepreneurship

Designed to produce graduates who can combine core business concepts with an entrepreneurial mindset to make a positive contribution to society, this course is run by Christian entrepreneurs, and offers access to a network of experienced entrepreneurs, a Startup Incubator and Accelerator, and the possibility of exclusive venture capital funding.

9 Core Subjects + 3 Elective Subjects

Diploma of Entrepreneurship and Diploma of Leadership

This course is designed to produce graduates who embody integrity and can combine Christian leadership principles with entrepreneurial skills to make a positive contribution to society. Solving Environmental Issues One Coffee Cup at a Time

The coffee industry generates 1.7 million tons of coffee husk waste each year and, in Australia alone, 1 billion takeaway coffee cups end up in landfill every year. Huskee is an Australian company tackling this environmental issue by developing a sophisticated and reusable coffee cup, made from coffee husks.

"There are plenty of ways to make a difference in business. Wouldn't it be wonderful if more people understood that having a successful business and finding solutions to real-world problems, especially environmental and social ones, aren't mutually exclusive?

Using Artificial Intelligence to Improve the Survival Rate of Cancer Patients

SIMON BIGGS

Radiotherapy Al, Member of The Guild of Entrepreneurs

You probably know of someone who has cancer, and most patients need radiotherapy.

Currently that involves a medical practitioner drawing manual lines to target treatment. Radiotherapy AI is a startup that uses Artificial Intelligence to draw those lines more precisely and efficiently to improve the quality and speed of treatment.

If used in every clinic, each year 30,000 extra patients would reach their two-year survival, while also saving 1,000,000 practitioner hours annually. This startup is practically saving lives.

"Creating this startup, solving this problem, has allowed me to use what God has aiven me to be a part of saving more lives than I have ever had the opportunity to do before. When push came to shove, I sought Him as to why it was that I needed to do it, I felt like His answer for me is "I need your heart in this field"."

FAQs & Pathways



What are the entry requirements?

DOMESTIC STUDENTS

For those who completed High School within the last 2 years, an ATAR of 65 for Bachelor degrees is required. VET and Diploma studies do not require the submission of an ATAR.

Applicants who did not complete High School or did not achieve a sufficient ATAR for their desired course but who completed a Certificate III equivalent or higher study are eligible for HE studies.

Applicants over the age of 21 can be eligible for admission on the basis of Provisional Entry and complete the Provisional Entry Qualifying Period (1 semester full-time or 4 units part-time) to become a full candidate.

Postgraduate studies require the completion of an AQF level 7 Bachelor degree or higher, each award having its own unique entry requirements.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The same academic requirements for Domestic Students apply to International Students. International Students must also provide evidence of English Language Proficiency – IELTS or equivalent. The minimum IELTS or equivalent score required differs by award so check the course pages on our website for details. International Students may be exempt from submitting an English Proficiency score if they are citizens of Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom or United States of America or if they have completed a Certificate IV or higher course within the last 2 years in Australia.



How do I finance my study?

Domestic students can choose to finance their studies via government loans — FEE-HELP, pay upfront or obtain a loan through private providers i.e. ZeeFi.

International students are required to pay an Enrolment Fee of \$200 and must submit their first semester's tuition in full to obtain a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE). Payments can be made by direct debit or BPOINT.

Students entering Education and Teaching courses via the Hub Model can access Scholarships and financial assistance. Each Hub offers different options and students will need to apply for scholarships and assistance with their hub directly.

We also offer Early Entry scholarships to high school leavers for select courses. Visit our website to find out more.



What is the difference between full-time and part-time study?

Higher education students can study part-time or full-time. Students can choose their study load each semester, which is 3-4 subjects per semester for a full-time load or 1-2 subjects per semester for a part-time load. Students may also apply for a Leave of Absence or defer their studies if they need a break due to changed circumstances. There are requirements for courses to be completed within a time period, such as the Diploma of Ministry which is 1 year full-time and up to 4 years part-time.

Pathways

We offer many pathways for you to start, progress or complete your studies to get to your destination.

For example, if you don't meet the entry requirements or are not sure about committing to a 3-year Bachelor degree, you can start with a 1-year Diploma, then decide after your 1st year whether to progress further. You can do the same with Postgraduate study - working up from a Graduate Certificate to a Masters. Our pathways give you flexible entry and exit options - talk to us to find out what suits you best!

UNDERGRADUATE

Expand your employment options by building from a diploma to a bachelor degree or a double degree.

POSTGRADUATE

You can start with just one semester of study and then continue on with further study to upgrade your qualification in your own time.

What are the delivery modes?

AC offers a choice of learning in different modes. These include online pre-recorded video classes, live Zoom classes or live, in-person classes and workshops. We also offer intensive or extensive classes, where the core content is covered over 3-5 days, and the students have the rest of the semester to learn at their own pace.


Students can also choose to combine some units from 3rd party education institutions to count as credit towards their AC degree (subject to approval by the relevant AC program director and head of school).

For people who want to access AC content and teaching without requiring a qualification, we offer the option of "auditing" some classes.

Lastly, each year we offer study tours to Israel, or Greece and Turkey. AC students, alumni, staff, family, and friends are welcome to join these life-changing tours.


When can I start my studies?

AC offers two main intakes a year — Semester 1 starting in March and Semester 2 starting in August, each running for 13 weeks with a 2 week mid-semester break. Some courses, such as Education, begin their classes in February and July respectively. There are also subjects being delivered as pre-semester intensives outside of these periods. Students can also study online in our Summer School period (November to February) to complete studies faster.
