Professor in Biblical Studies

Jacqui is a Professor in Biblical Studies who specialises in hermeneutics and Old Testament Studies. Jacqui speaks regularly at local and international events and has appeared on various national TV and radio programs in Australia. She has previously lived in Turkey as a missionary and has also hiked the Camino de Santiago (800km across Spain). Her research interests include Pentecostal hermeneutics, prophetic literature, and feminist readings of Scripture.

ASSOC PROF BEN MYERS Graduate Research School Director

Ben is the Director of the Graduate Research School who specialises in literature and theology, and early Christian thought. He has published extensive works in the many areas of theology with a particular focus in modern theology and seventeenth century England. Ben is half Serbian; his mother's family came to Australia as refugees from Yugoslavia. He grew up living in a beach shack on Magnetic Island in far north Queensland, writing his first book at the age of 5 and was surprised when no one offered to publish it.



Certificate IV in Ministry and Discipleship

This entry-level certificate gives you a very practical introduction to ministry and discipleship through a mix of core units and electives. Acquire discipleship skills, grow your faith, and learn to communicate biblical principles. Be equipped for ministry as an effective church team member or even a team leader.

6 Core Units + 2 Elective Units

Diploma of Ministry

The Diploma of Ministry is a stand-alone one-year program and a potential pathway into the Bachelor of Ministry. This course gives you a thorough foundation in theology and ministry, and includes a practical workplace experience component. Elective subjects cover Communication and Leadership Skills, Children's Ministry, Youth Ministry, Worship, Christian Spirituality, and Evangelism.

Bachelor of Ministry

The Bachelor of Ministry is a three-year degree providing foundations in practical ministry skills, and theology and biblical studies, offering specialisations including Ministry, Humanities, or Chaplaincy. This course will equip you for teaching, preaching, and senior leadership roles in churches and other ministry organisations.

Bachelor of Theology

The Bachelor of Theology is a three-year degree similar to the Bachelor of Ministry, offering its own specialisations including Ancient Languages or Christian Studies. This course will equip you for teaching, preaching, and senior leadership roles in churches and other ministry organisations.

Master of Arts

The Master of Arts is a flexible postgraduate qualification with opportunities to specialise in Chaplaincy, Christian Studies, and Counselling, in addition to a wide range of electives offered by AC. The research and writing skills gained will be applicable to most workplaces including, but not limited to, churches and not-for-profit organisations. The Master of Arts can also be a pathway towards further research and doctoral studies.

Ruth Lesmana

Through AC's student-led missions initiative, Sounds of Silence, Ruth developed an interest in anti-trafficking movements. After her studies she felt called to the Thai-Myanmar border to work with displaced people affected by the long-running civil war. For eight years she transformed communities where people were at risk of human trafficking. She built partnerships with organisations in the area, taught English and vocational skills, and assisted with natural farming and sustainability projects. Now back in Australia, Ruth has devoted herself to helping refugees settle in Australia and has recently been awarded Local Woman of the Year by Camden Council for her work.



Master of Theology

The Master of Theology provides a unique opportunity to engage in innovative research and critical exploration of contemporary issues. You can specialise in Biblical Studies, Theology or Christian History. You will be trained to communicate complex ideas and propose solutions to a wide audience, as well as design and implement an advanced research thesis. Your research can prepare you for ministry and leadership roles in church, academic, and community settings. It is also a potential pathway to doctoral studies (PhD).

Graduate Certificate in Leadership

Study can be daunting, but leaders with little or no formal education can enter through Professional Entry into this course. New students benefit from extensive study support and a dynamic learning cohort to help you succeed in your studies and your leadership. Your effectiveness will be transformed by a trusted, proven Christian framework to guide your leadership and grow your organisation to be healthy, effective, and life-impacting. It is also a pathway into the Master of Leadership or Master of Arts.

It is also a pathway into special research and doctoral studies (including DMin or PhD).

FAQs & Pathways

What are the entry requirements?



DOMESTIC STUDENTS

For those who completed High School within the last 2 years, an ATAR of 65 for Bachelor degrees is required. VET and Diploma studies do not require the submission of an ATAR.

Applicants who did not complete High School or did not achieve a sufficient ATAR for their desired course but who completed a Certificate III equivalent or higher study are eligible for HE studies.

Applicants over the age of 21 can be eligible for admission on the basis of Provisional Entry and complete the Provisional Entry Qualifying Period (1 semester full-time or 4 units part-time) to become a full candidate.

Postgraduate studies require the completion of an AQF level 7 Bachelor degree or higher, each award having its own unique entry requirements, for example, applicants for the Graduate Certificate in Leadership may be considered for professional entry based on their experience.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The same academic requirements for Domestic Students apply to International Students.

International Students must also provide evidence of English Language Proficiency — IELTS or equivalent.

The minimum IELTS or equivalent score required differs by award so check the course pages on our website for details. International Students may be exempt from submitting an English Proficiency score if they are citizens of Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom or United States of America or if they have completed a Certificate IV or higher course within the last 2 years in Australia.



How do I finance my study?

Domestic students can choose to finance their studies via government loans — FEE-HELP, pay upfront or obtain a loan through private providers i.e. ZeeFi.

International students are required to pay an Enrolment Fee of \$200 and must submit their first semester's tuition in full to obtain a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE). Payments can be made by direct debit or BPOINT.

Students entering Education and Teaching courses via the Hub Model can access Scholarships and financial assistance. Each Hub offers different options and students will need to apply for scholarships and assistance with their hub directly.

We also offer Early Entry scholarships to high school leavers for select courses. Visit our website to find out more.



What is the difference between full-time and part-time study?

Higher education students can study part-time or full-time. Students can choose their study load each semester, which is 3-4 subjects per semester for a full-time load or 1-2 subjects per semester for a part-time load. Students may also apply for a Leave of Absence or defer their studies if they need a break due to changed circumstances. There are requirements for courses to be completed within a time period, such as the Diploma of Ministry which is 1 year full-time and up to 4 years part-time.

Pathways

We offer many pathways for you to start, progress or complete your studies to get to your destination.

For example, if you don't meet the entry requirements or are not sure about committing to a 3-year Bachelor degree, you can start with a 1-year Diploma, then decide after your 1st year whether to progress further. You can do the same with Postgraduate study — working up from a Graduate Certificate to a Masters. Our pathways give you flexible entry and exit options — talk to us to find out what suits you best!

Expand your employment options by building from a diploma to a bachelor degree or a double degree.

What are the delivery modes?

AC offers a choice of learning in different modes. These include online pre-recorded video classes, live Zoom classes or live, in-person classes and workshops. We also offer intensive or extensive classes, where the core content is covered over 3-5 days, and the students have the rest of the semester to learn at their own pace.

Students can also choose to combine some units from 3rd party education institutions to count as credit towards their AC degree (subject to approval by the relevant AC program director and head of school).

For people who want to access AC content and teaching without requiring a qualification, we offer the option of "auditing" some classes.

Lastly, each year we offer study tours to Israel, or Greece and Turkey. AC students, alumni, staff, family, and friends are welcome to join these life-changing tours.



When can I start my studies?

AC offers two main intakes a year — Semester 1 starting in March and Semester 2 starting in August, each running for 13 weeks with a 2 week mid-semester break. Some courses, such as Education, begin their classes in February and July respectively. There are also subjects being delivered as pre-semester intensives outside of these periods. Students can also study online in our Summer School period (November to February) to complete studies faster.
