Course Structure of Study

To be eligible to graduate with the Diploma of Chaplaincy, a candidate shall accrue at least 80 credit points.

The Diploma of Chaplaincy award comprises of:

- 6 core units
 - 2 elective units

Electives

Any unit that is not a Diploma of Chaplaincy core unit is classified as an Elective subject. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

For example, THE002 Pentecostal Worldview is not a Diploma of Chaplaincy core unit. To enrol into the subject, you must meet the pre-requisite by completed THE001 Christian worldview.

Intensive Structure

The Diploma of Chaplaincy consists of compulsory intensive classes where students are required to attend. Please take note that not all units are intensive based.
