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BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (PRIMARY)

Course Structure of Study

The Bachelor of Education (Primary) award comprises of:

- 31 Education Subjects
- 1 Elective Subject

To qualify for the Bachelor of Education (Primary) degree a candidate shall accrue at least 320 credit points, including the satisfactory completion of the rules noted below:

- Maximum 10 subjects (100 credit points) at 100 level
 - Minimum 8 subjects (80 credit points) at 300 level
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Elective Subject

Any unit that is not within the Bachelor of Education (Primary) award is classified as an elective subject. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

For example, MAN201 Organisational Behaviour is a unit outside of the Bachelor of Education (Primary) award. You must meet the pre-requisite by completed MAN101 Introduction to Management.
