Course Structure of Study

The Diploma of Arts award comprises of:

- 2 Core units
- 6 Elective units

To be eligible to graduate with the Diploma of Arts, a candidate shall accrue at least 80 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the rules noted below.

- Maximum of 4 subjects (40 credit points) at 100 level

If you complete more than 4 subjects at 100 level, the units will not contribute to your progress in the Diploma of Arts award and the unit will be an additional subject on your transcript.

Elective Unit

Any unit that is not a core subject in the Diploma of Arts is classified as an elective subject. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

For example, MAN201 Organisational Behaviour is not a core unit of the Diploma of Arts award. Therefore, it is classified as an elective subject. You must meet the pre-requisite of 40 credit points and completed MAN101 Introduction to Management to enrol into MAN201 Organisational Behaviour.

Enrolment Guide

It is important that you speak with the relevant course coordinator regarding your enrolment selection. Use this as a guide to complete the Diploma of Arts award.
