Course Structure of Study

The Graduate Diploma in Arts comprises of:

- 2 Core units
- 6 Elective units

To be eligible to graduate with the Graduate Diploma in Arts, a candidate shall accrue at least 80 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the rules noted below:

- Minimum 2 subjects (20 credit points) at 500 level

Use the following as a guide to complete the Graduate Diploma in Arts award. It is strongly recommended to complete the Core subjects first.

What is an Elective unit?

Any unit that is not a core subject in the Graduate Diploma in Arts is classified as an elective subject. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

For example, BIB533 Esther is a not a core unit of the Graduate Diploma in Arts award. Therefore, it is classified as an elective subject. You must meet the pre-requisite of completing BIB401 Introduction to the Bible to enrol in BIB533 Esther.
