

# ENROLMENT GUIDE

## MASTER OF THEOLOGY

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### Course Structure of Study

The Master of Theology award comprises of:

- 60 credit points of Core Research
- 40 credit points of an area of specialisation (Major)
- 20 credit points of Elective unit(s)

To qualify for the Master of Theology degree a candidate shall accrue at least 120 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the rules noted below:

- Elective unit(s) is to be a minimum level 500 subject outside of your area of specialisation
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### Area of Specialisation – Major

The following are Major's offered in the Master of Theology. A candidate is to select one major and complete the requirements:

- Biblical Studies
  - Theology
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### Elective Unit

A unit within an alternate major is classified as an elective subject. For example, if you have chosen the Biblical studies major and you would like to complete a unit within the Theology major, this will be classified as an elective unit.

A unit outside of the Master of Theology award is classified as an elective subject. For example, if you are to enrol into COM505 Intercultural Communication, which is outside of the Master of Theology award, this will be classified as an elective unit

To enrol into an elective within the discipline of your Major, you must seek approval of the Program Director, Dr. Adam White. For example, if you are completing the Theology major and you decide to enrol into a Theology unit not within the Master of Theology award, you must seek approval from the Program Director.

An Elective unit must be a minimum 500 level subject. If you complete any subject below 500 level, it will not contribute to your progress in the Master of Theology and the unit will be an additional unit on your transcript.

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### Enrolment Guide

It is important that you speak with the Program Director regarding your enrolment selection. Use this as a guide to complete the Master of Theology award.

- **Pre-requisite units are show in red**
  - Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject
  - CP means credit points
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### Core Research Subjects

- RES601 Research methods – 20CP
  - (RES601)** RES602 Research Project – 40CP
- 

### Electives

An elective within your chosen major requires approval by the Program Director. For example;

- If you select the Biblical Studies major, seek approval to enrol into a BIB unit
- If you select the Theology major, seek approval to enrol into a THE unit

### Select an Elective Option: **A OR B**

#### Option A

- 600 level subject (from below Major's) – 20CP

#### Option B

- 500 level subject – 10CP
  - 500 level subject – 10CP
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### Biblical Studies Major

- (RES601)** BIB601 Methods in Biblical Studies – 20CP
  - (BIB601)** BIB602 Seminar Presentation of Research in Biblical Studies – 20CP
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### Theology Major

- (RES601)** THE601 Theologians: Method and Meaning – 20CP
  - (THE601)** THE602 Seminar Presentation of Theological Research – 20CP
