### Course Structure of Study

The Graduate Diploma of Leadership comprises of:

- 6 Core units
- 2 Elective units

To be eligible to graduate with the Graduate Diploma of Leadership, a candidate shall accrue at least 80 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the rules noted below:

- Core Units: 60 Credit Points
  - Electives: 20 Credit Points worth of 400, 500 or 600 level subjects.

Use the following as a guide to complete the Graduate Diploma of Leadership award. It is strongly recommended to complete the Core subjects first.

### What is an Elective unit?

Any unit that is not a core subject in the Graduate Diploma of Leadership is classified as an elective subject. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

For example, BIB533 Esther is not a core unit of the Graduate Diploma of Leadership award. Therefore, it is classified as an elective subject. You must meet the pre-requisite of completing BIB401 Introduction to the Bible to enrol in BIB533 Esther.
