One semester full-time, or part-time with completion by December 2021.

Course Structure

The course structure is based on the first two semesters (each of 13 weeks duration) of the Undergraduate Certificate in Arts, with four subjects taught in each semester. It comprises:

- 10 cp from Research
- 10 cp from Christian Studies
- 20 cp electives

To qualify for award of the degree of Undergraduate Certificate in Arts a candidate shall accrue an aggregate of at least 40 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the core subjects.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Course Levels

100, 200 or 300 level is indicated in the course code e.g THE201 is a 200 level theology unit, whereas LEA301 is a 300 level leadership unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.

Pre-requisites

A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. For example, in order to attempt THE201, you must complete THE101. Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject.
