Course Structure

The course consists of 240 credit points comprising:

- 1 x core research methods subject (20 credit points)
- 1 x 800-level elective to be taken from the area of specialisation (20 credit points)
- 1 x core 50,000 research thesis in area of specialisation (200 credit points)

To qualify for award of the degree of Doctor of Ministry a candidate shall complete at least 240 credit points.

Area of Specialisation (Major)

The following are areas of specialisation offered in the Doctor of Ministry. You are to select one area of specialisation and complete the requirements

- Leadership
- Ministry
