GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN ARTS

Course Duration

Full-time load 1 year
Part-time up to 3 years

Study Modes

Face-to-face, Online

Intakes

Semester 1, Semester 2

Course Structure

The proposed course structure is based on two semesters (each of 13 weeks duration), with four subjects taught in each semester (for a full-time study load). It comprises:

- 2 compulsory core subjects (20 credit points)
- 6 elective subjects (60 credit points)

To be eligible to graduate with the Graduate Diploma in Arts, a candidate shall accrue at least 80 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the rules noted below:

- Minimum 2 subjects (20 credit points) at 500 level

If students are planning on continuing into the Master of Arts, they should bear in mind the Master of Arts has distinct requirements for a specialisation, and plan accordingly. Please see the Master of Arts enrolment guide for more information.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Elective Subjects

Any unit that is not a core subject in the Graduate Diploma in Arts is classified as an elective subject. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

For example, BIB533 Esther is a not a core unit of the Graduate Diploma in Arts award. Therefore, it is classified as an elective subject. You must meet the pre-requisite of completing BIB401 Introduction to the Bible to enrol in BIB533 Esther.

Course Levels

100, 200 or 300 level is indicated in the course code e.g THE201 is a 200 level theology unit, whereas LEA301 is a 300 level leadership unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.

Pre-requisites

A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. For example, in order to attempt THE201, you must complete THE101. Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject.
