Course Duration

Full-time load 3 years

Course Structure

The course structure is based on six semesters (each of 12 weeks duration, plus an exam week), with four subjects taught in each semester. It comprises:

- 20 credit points of core subjects;
- 80 credit points of major discipline specialisation subjects;
- 40 credit points of minor discipline specialisation subjects;
- 100 credit points of electives.

To qualify for award of the degree of Bachelor of Arts a candidate shall complete at least 240 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the core subjects noted below.

- Minor Specialisation

- Chaplaincy (SSC and SSE)

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Elective Subjects

If you have completed the requirements of a Major, any additional unit completed within the major or other major is classified as an Elective subject.

Elective Rules: 100 credit points of electives (at least 10 credit points at 300 level).

Course Levels

100, 200 or 300 level is indicated in the course code e.g THE201 is a 200 level theology unit, whereas LEA301 is a 300 level leadership unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.

Pre-requisites

A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. For example, in order to attempt THE201, you must complete THE101. Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject.
