Course Structure

The Bachelor of Arts award comprises of:

- 20 credit points of core subjects
- 80 credit points of major discipline specialisation subjects
- 40 credit points of minor discipline specialisation subjects
- 100 credit points of elective subjects

To qualify for award of the degree of Bachelor of Arts, a candidate shall complete at least 240 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the core subjects noted below.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Elective Subjects

Any unit that is not within the Bachelor of Arts award is classified as an Elective subject. Before enrolling into an Elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

Note: It is possible to undertake a second major or minor discipline specialisation using some electives.

Course Levels

100, 200 or 300 level is indicated in the course code e.g THE201 is a 200 level theology unit, whereas LEA301 is a 300 level leadership unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.

Pre-requisites A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. For example, in order to attempt THE201, you must complete THE101. Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject.
