# DOCTOR OF MINISTRY

## Course Duration

Full-time load 3 years

Part-time up to 10 years

## Course Structure

The course consists of 240 credit points, comprising:

- 1 x core research methods subject (20 credit points)
- 1 x 800-level elective to be taken from the area of specialisation (20 credit points)
- 1 x core research thesis or research portfolio (50 000 words or equivalent) in area of specialisation (200 credit points)

To qualify for award of the degree of Doctor of Ministry a candidate shall complete at least 240 credit points.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

### Course Levels

600, 700 or 800 level is indicated in the course code e.g BIB601 is a 600 level biblical unit, whereas RES801 is a 800 level research unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.

### Pre-requisites and Co-requisites

A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. A co-requisite is a unit that can be studied concurrently with another unit.
