# UNDERGRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN ARTS

#### **Course Duration**

Full-time load 6 months Part-time up to 1.5 years

### **Study Modes**

Face-to-face, Online

#### **Intakes**

Semester 1, Semester 2

#### **Course Structure**

The course structure is based on one semester (of 13 weeks duration), with four subjects taught in the semester (for a full-time study load). It comprises:

- 10 credit points from Research
- 10 credit points from Christian Studies
- 20 credit points of elective subjects from Business, Education or Theology

To qualify for award of the degree of Undergraduate Certificate in Arts a candidate shall accrue an aggregate of at least 40 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the core subjects noted below.

# WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

# **Elective Subjects**

In this award, students may select elective subjects from Business, Education or Theology. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

#### **Course Levels**

100, 200 or 300 level is indicated in the course code e.g THE201 is a 200 level theology unit, whereas LEA301 is a 300 level leadership unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.

## **Pre-requisites**

A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. For example, in order to attempt THE201, you must complete THE101. Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject.
