COURSE OVERVIEW

Course Duration

Full-time load 1.5 years Part-time up to 6 years

Study Modes

Face-to-face, online

Intakes

Semester 1, Semester 2 & Summer School

Course Structure

This course structure is based on three semesters (each of 13 weeks duration), with four subjects taught in each semester.

- It comprises of:
 - 8 core subjects (80 credit points)
 - 4 elective subjects (40 credit points)

To qualify for award of the double degree of Diploma of Chaplaincy and Diploma of Leadership a candidate shall accrue an aggregate of at least 120 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the core subjects.

Elective Subjects

Any unit that is not a core subject in the Diploma of Chaplaincy or the Diploma of Leadership is classified as an elective subject. Before enrolling into an elective subject, ensure that you have met the pre-requisite for that unit.

An optional specialisation in Community Chaplaincy is available to all students. Students interested in becoming accredited Chaplains **must** complete the elective units in this specialisation.
