GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN PROFESSIONAL SUPERVISION

Course overview

The Graduate Certificate in Professional Supervision provides professional training in supervision for those in the caring professions who have a responsibility of support and oversight for others.

The course is overseen by Associate Professor Rebecca Loundar and Dr Michael Paterson, Director of the Institute of Pastoral Supervision & Reflective Practice (UK)

Course Duration

Part-time: 1-2 years

Course Structure

The course structure is based on semesters (13 weeks duration). It comprises:

- 4 core subjects (40 credit points)

To qualify for award of the degree of Graduate Certificate in Professional Supervision a candidate shall accrue an aggregate of 40 credit points comprising the 4 core units.

What you need to know

Pre-requisites

A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. For example, in order to attempt SSC514, you must complete SSC412. Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject.

Course Levels

400 or 500 level is indicated in the course code e.g., SSC410 is a 400-level Social Science unit, whereas RES500 is a 500-level Research unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.
