# BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (SECONDARY)

## Course Duration

Full-time load 4 years

Part-time up to 12 years

## Study Modes

Face-to-face, online

## Intakes

Semester 1, Semester 2

## Course Structure

The course structure is based on eight semesters (each of 13 weeks duration), with four subjects taught in each semester:

- 10 cp from Research
- 10 cp from Christian Studies
- 120 cp from Education
- 40 cp from Curriculum Studies
- 60 cp Discipline Studies – Major
- 40 cp Discipline Studies - Minor
- 40 cp Professional Experience

Professional Experience (including Community Engagement) consisting of community-based learning and a minimum number of supervised teaching days in secondary schools as stipulated by local registration/ employing bodies.

To qualify for the award of the degree of Bachelor of Education (Secondary) a candidate shall accrue an aggregate of at least 320 credit points, including satisfactory completion of the core subjects noted below

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

### Course Levels

100, 200 or 300 level is indicated in the course code e.g THE201 is a 200 level theology unit, whereas LEA301 is a 300 level leadership unit. The units increase in difficulty and build upon content and concepts that have come before.

**Pre-requisites** A pre-requisite is a unit that must be successfully completed before attempting another unit. For example, in order to attempt THE201, you must complete THE101. Students must have completed the pre-requisite to enrol in the subject.
